



CONFLICT MINERALS DECLARATION

Dear Valued Customer:

In the United States, the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act in U.S. Congress HR 4173 section 1502 “Conflict Minerals” was signed into law on July 2010. The law imposes direct Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) reporting requirements on any Conflict Minerals which are necessary to the functionality or production of a company’s products. Conflict Minerals by definition are: tin (cassiterite), tungsten (wolframite), tantalum, (coltan), and gold which are known to be mined in conditions of armed conflict and human rights violations. Located primarily in the Eastern provinces of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries. The profits from the sale of these minerals finance armed conflict and human rights atrocities. This law was finalized on August 22, 2012 and requires impacted companies to comply on a yearly basis.

Components Express, Inc. Is committed to complying with this legislation and is taking steps to comply with the regulations. We are in the continual process of contacting our suppliers to determine what information is currently available with regard to the presence of “Conflict Minerals” in our product lines.
